Pool Play and Championship Bracket (single Elimination)

Tie Breaker: Head to Head, then Goals Against, then Goal Differential, last flip coin

After Pool Play, teams will be seeded for Bracket Play, single-elimination. Seeding is determined by Pool Finish/Places. Any tie situations will be worked out using tie-breaker rules.

- All players are midfielders and there are no offsides. Quick free clear after goals (no defending goalie on free clear unless goalie comes out the crease).
- Goalie cannot go past midfield.
- A central horn will start and end all games.
- Current US Lacrosse Rules will apply.
- 6 field players 1 goalie
- 12 Minute running clock halves
- NO timeouts allowed.
- 2 minute half-time
- 4 minutes between games
- Current US Lacrosse Rules will apply.
- Time kept via Central Horn
- Official score kept at the scorer's table AND ARE FINAL
- Ties are allowed in pool play / 1v1 Braveheart in Bracket Play (Goalie must stay in crease)
- Games start with draw at midfield (1 player each team all others must be inside the 12 meter arc). 2nd half starts with losing team taking possession at midfield and players may be anywhere on field, unless tied at half in which case 2nd half starts with daw at midfield.
- Goalie can not go past midfield on a clear
- Middle school and high school divisions play full checking.
- Lower School divisions will play modified checking and 3 second rule as defined by US lacrosse for good defense. One pass rule is NOT in effect. Mercy Rule not in effect.
- 8 Meter free positions will be played out with .03 seconds if foul occurs before time expires.
- Any player that receives a red card will be required to sit out for the remainder of game and the next game.
- Goalies may play on multiple teams. Field players CANNOT play on multiple teams
 UNLESS both coaches agree at start of the game.
- Inclement weather delays (ANRP has lightning sirens)
 - 1. If a game is at half or more, the game will be considered final.
 - 2. Tournament director reserves the right to adjust game times as necessary in the event of weather delays.

SPORTSMANSHIP: All coaches, players, & Spectators are to conduct themselves properly and display GOOD SPORTSMANSHIP. Respect each other and especially the refs!
